

Keep Kids Safe...



On January 1, 2010 a new Illinois law went into effect regarding cell phone usage in school zones. The new law states that a person, regardless of age, may not use a wireless phone at any time while operating a motor vehicle on a roadway in a school speed zone. There are exceptions for a person engaged in an emergency and when the phone is in voice-activated mode.



Another new law that began on January 1, 2010, states it is illegal to compose, send or read text messages, read or compose e-mail, look at the Internet or otherwise compose or send any type of electronic message while driving.

Please keep students and drivers safe by observing the law each day.
